

He published a research paper as its main author in 1992 titled "Stereospecific high-performance liquid chromatographic assay of pirprofen enantiomers in rat plasma and urine," demonstrating his experience in pharmaceutical research. In 1993, another pharmaceutical study titled "Influence of the route of administration on the pharmacokinetics of pirprofen enantiomers in the rat" was published. 
### HAPPY NEW YEAR 2023!
