After completing high school, he pursued a Bachelor of Business in Australia, majoring in accounting, which provided him with skills in financial management and analysis for a career in the accounting industry. Following his graduation, he set a two-year goal to gain practical experience in Singapore’s competitive business environment to enhance his industry knowledge before returning to support his family business.

In 2011, Mr. Leong Kia Chun modernized the brand through business restructuring, marketing roadshows, and a centralized kitchen in 2015, boosting efficiency. By 2017, Leong established Taka Patisserie, 1st branch located at TT3 Tabuan Tranquility offering pastries, desserts, and event catering under the tagline “Love Begins Here.”

The COVID-19 pandemic accelerated Taka’s digital growth, leading to the opening of 11 new outlets, including its landmark 31st outlet at Saradise, Malaysia’s first three-storey bakery café which awarded by Malaysia Book of Record. Now operating over 35 outlets across Malaysia, Taka is Halal-certified and led by expert chefs. Future plans include Sarawak’s first Bakery Tourism Factory and Taka Patisserie Academy, fostering an ecosystem for bakery enthusiasts and strengthening its industry leadership.

Aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, Taka promotes initiatives to reduce poverty and hunger and empowers employees through an internal entrepreneurship platform and profit-sharing model. Balancing tradition with innovation, Taka spreads the joy of Sarawak’s authentic flavors while inspiring growth and community engagement.

### Growth Strategies

TAKA Group is committed to becoming Malaysia’s first Bakery Retail Ecosystem, showcasing the authentic taste of Sarawak and Malaysian Halal products to international audiences by focusing on Tourism, Sarawak Culture, Health, Education and Training. With plans to expand into Southeast Asia within five years, the company is building a sustainable business foundation for future generations.

Under Mr. Leong’s leadership, Taka has diversified into five key segments: centralized kitchen operations, a network of 35 retail outlets, investments in commercial properties, franchising, and event management. These

The planned TAKA Tourism Flagship Store located at Batu Kawa Banquet Square Kuching exemplifies Taka's vision of merging healthy baking, education, and local culture into a unique experience for tourists and locals. With a focus on collaboration, innovation, and sustainability, Taka aims to scale its presence nationally and regionally, delivering on its mission: "Together We Make It Happen!"
